Eligibility Criteria for Masters' Programme for Indian and International Students

- Minimum criteria is 55% or 2.2/4.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) or equivalent GPA in Undergraduate/Bachelor's Degree
 - Students from any stream i.e Humanities/Sciences/ Engineering/Management/Law, etc. can apply for any programme However, they may not apply for more than two programmes
 - Self-Introduction/Bio-Note Statement (not more than 250 words)
 - Statement of Purpose (SoP)
 - Why do you want to study at Nalanda University? (100 words)
 - The reasons for choosing the programme (300 – 500 words)
 - Proof of English proficiency is required for students coming from non-English speaking countries/medium: TOEFL/IELTS or any other standard certification in English
- *The candidate having full-time degree-level course, entirely taught and assessed in English need not submit any certificate

For MBA in Sustainable Development and Management

- In addition to the above criteria, for Indian students, a minimum score of 70 percentile in CAT or XAT or MAT is required
 - For International students, a minimum credit score/GPA at Undergraduate level to be 3.0/4.0 GPA or equivalent GPA or relevant GMAT score
 - For Working Executives
 - Minimum 5 years of working experience
 - No Objection Certificate is required from employer for working executives/sponsored candidates/ candidates on sabbatical/ candidates recommended by PSUs/GoI Departments
 - CAT/XAT/MAT score will not be applicable
- * The University reserves the right to admission for meritorious/ experienced candidates

SELECTION

- Both Indian and International students will be selected on the basis of Statement of Purpose (SoP), Self Introductory Note, and Interview. All documents will be checked for plagiarism

Interview Schedule: Shortlisted Indian and International Students will be called for Interview from 31st March 2021 onwards
